



We have a text logo and symbol, you can use them both individually or in combinations with each other (see p. 4-5)






Space



Always leave the logo some space to breathe **x** - height of the letter **"O"**




Variations



The horizontal logo is the highest priority. Pay attention to the distance between the symbol and text logo — it is strictly regulated.


Variations



If you need to place the logo in a vertical composition, you can use the vertical logo.




Circle












































































































Colours


